1. All site plans, concept drawings, maps, illustrations, diagrams, renderings, for the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
2. All letters, correspondence, transmittals, emails, briefings, staff reports, memoranda, memos, between the Department of Public Services and any other City department, division, office, or staff regarding the Prop 5 Facility and all proposed sports complex properties from 2002 to present.
3. All letters, correspondence, emails, memos, briefings, memoranda, transmittals, staff reports, between the Department of Public Services and all other federal, state and local government entities regarding the Prop 5 Facility and all proposed sports complex properties from 2002 to present.
4. All M.O.U.s, cooperative agreements, interlocal cooperative agreements, letters of intent, contracts, agreements, purchase agreements, promises, exchange agreements, gift agreements, service agreements, management agreements, plans, between Salt Lake City Corporation, the Department of Public Services, the Office of the Mayor, or any other City office and all private, nonprofit and governmental entities regarding the location, design, planning, construction, funding, management, use, governance, and operation of the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
5. All M.O.U.s, cooperative agreements, interlocal cooperative agreements, letters of intent, contracts, agreements, purchase agreements, land transfer agreements, promises, exchange agreements, deed restrictions, conservation easements, between Salt Lake City Corporation, the Department of Public Services, the Office of the Mayor, or any other City office and all private, nonprofit and governmental entities regarding the acquisition, sale, trade, exchange or transfer of any and all land and real property for the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
6. All reports, studies, plans, assessments, delineations, analyses, related to the siting, planning, design, construction, feasibility, need, economics, revenues, operating costs, transportation, engineering, cost estimates, tax benefits, environmental impacts, use, of the Prop 5 Facility, from 2002 to present, including but not limited to:

 - b. Needs assessments, cost-benefits analyses, feasibility studies, economic impacts and benefits analyses, cost-revenues studies, reports and analyses;
 - c. Environmental assessments, surveys and delineations;
 - d. Environmental impacts studies;
 - e. Transportation studies;
 - f. Traffic flow, roads and emergency vehicle access analyses;
 - g. Revenue projections;
 - h. Operation and maintenance cost to use studies and projections;

- i. Cumulative impacts studies;
 - j. Engineering studies and flood control/prevention analyses;
 - k. Recreational demand and needs analyses;
 - l. Public subsidies and future taxation analyses;
 - m. Health risk assessments;
 - n. Engineering surveys;
 - o. Wildlife assessments.
7. All design budgets, pro forma cost projections, revenue projections, operating cost estimates, maintenance budgets, construction budgets, land acquisition budgets for the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
 8.  9. All plans, drawings, schematics, and reports regarding the proposed secondary water irrigation system for the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
 10. All engineering studies, traffic studies, designs, plans, concept drawings for roads, parking lots, and bridges related to the Prop 5 Facility from 2002 to present.
 11. All historical plans, studies, analyses, reports regarding the Prop 5 Facility before 2002, meaning all related documents regarding design, location, features, amenities, dimensions, costs, rankings for the Regional Sports Complex as planned by the City before the Prop 5 Bond.
 12. All records of public meetings, workshops, hearings regarding the determination of a location for the Prop 5 Facility.
 13. All preliminary reports, studies, plans, cost estimates for the Prop 5 Bond.
 14. All records, transmittals, letters, emails, memos, memoranda, agreements, contracts, permits, records of meetings (dates, times, locations), meeting agendas, meeting notes, meeting minutes, briefings, M.O.U.s, exchange agreements, management agreements, transfer agreements, land exchange agreements, management agreements, approvals between Salt Lake City Corporation and the Utah Division of Parks and Recreation, including the State Parks Board, regarding the exchange, sale, use, lease, trade, transfer, change of use, management of properties along the Jordan River that relate to the Prop 5 Facility location at roughly 2100 North, and all similar or related documents involving Salt Lake City Corporation, the Utah Division of Parks and Recreation and the National Park Service (agents for the Land and Water Conservation Fund) from 2002 to present.

All information and documents including plans, diagrams, descriptions, maps, meeting notes, letters, emails, records of meetings, transmittals, memos, memoranda, cooperative agreements, approvals, contracts, agreements, gifts, commitments involving Salt Lake City, REAL Salt Lake, REAL Madrid, Utah Soccer Stadium Owners, LLC., Utah Youth Soccer Association, regarding the creation, location, design, or construction of a professional soccer team training facility and /or a soccer academy in Salt Lake City from 2002 to present.
